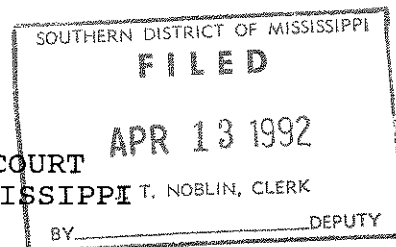


JUDGMENT OF ACQUITTAL

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court for trial on March 31, 1992 whereupon a jury composed of twelve (12) good and lawful jurors were selected, paneled, and accepted by both the United States and the Defendant, and who were duly sworn.

Whereupon after hearing all of the evidence introduced, argument of counsel, and receiving the instructions of the Court, the jury retired to consider their verdict and thereby returned into open Court the following verdict: "We the Jury find the Defendant, Carolyn Barnes, a/k/a Carolyn F. Bond, not guilty."

It is thereupon ordered by the Court that the Defendant is adjudicated not guilty and this Judgment of Acquittal shall be entered.
