

 Bodne v. King Miss., 2003.

Wife brought divorce action against husband on grounds of habitual cruel and unusual treatment. The Chancery Court, Hinds County, [Pat Wise](#), Chancellor, granted divorce. Husband appealed. The Court of Appeals reversed. Granting certiorari, the Supreme Court, [Pittman](#), C.J., held that: (1) evidence supported finding of husband's unnatural and infamous conduct in divorce proceeding based on habitual cruel and unusual treatment, and (2) husband had conveyed contested property to wife, commingling property, and thus property was properly deemed marital property subject to division.

Judgment of Court of Appeals reversed; Chancery Court judgment reinstated and affirmed.
