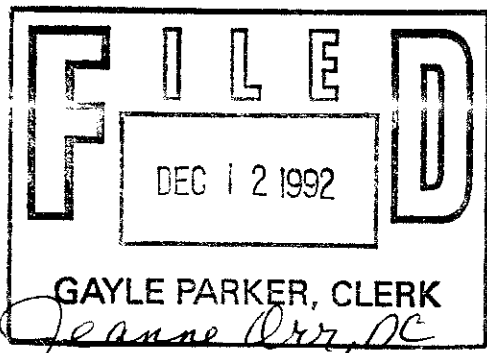
O R D E R


Comes the Assistant District Attorney, Bennie Crumpton, who prosecutes for the State of Mississippi and comes the defendant, MICHAEL HUTCHINS, in his own proper person, with his attorney of record, Merrida Coxwell, who was brought before the Court and having been arraigned in open Court and having the indictment preferred against him herein of "MURDER", and having plead Not Guilty to said charge, and says that he is Not Guilty. Thereupon comes a Jury composed of Odessa H. Gamage, and eleven (11) others together with four (4) alternates all good and lawful men and women of Harrison County, Mississippi, who were empaneled, accepted by both the State and the defendant, who were duly sworn according to law, and after hearing all of the evidence, argument of counsel and receiving the instructions of the Court, retired with the exception of the Four (4) alternates, who were then and there excused by the Court, to consider their verdict, being in charge of sworn officers of the law and presently returned into open Court and in the presence and hearing of the defendant and his counsel, the following verdict, to-wit:

"We, the jury find the defendant, Michael Hutchins, Not Guilty.

It is hereby ordered by the Court that the defendant go hence, without delay.
