Defendants were convicted in the Circuit Court, Rankin County, James W. Smith, Jr., Special Judge, of conspiracy to possess heroin, and they appealed. The Supreme Court, Prather, J., held that: (1) evidence was sufficient to sustain defendants' convictions, but (2) trial court, in sentencing defendants to 20 years imprisonment and \$20,000 fine and ten years imprisonment and \$5,000 fine, respectively, exceeded statutory maximum.

Affirmed and remanded for resentencing.
