Defendant was convicted of sexual battery by the Circuit Court, Hinds County, William F. Coleman, J., by jury verdict. Defendant was sentenced as habitual offender to 30 years without probation or parole. Defendant appealed. The Supreme Court, Prather, J., held that: (1) the trial court did not abuse its discretion by refusing to suppress victim's in-court identification; (2) sufficient evidence supported defendant's conviction; and (3) defendant's sentence was not excessive.

Affirmed.
