Defendant was convicted in the Circuit Court, Hinds County, [William F. Coleman, J.](#), of capital murder, and he appealed. The Supreme Court, Roy Noble Lee, C.J., held that statutory 270-day speedy trial period commenced to run when defendant, who had originally been arraigned on indictment for murder less than capital, was reindicted for capital murder.

Affirmed.
