Defendant was convicted by jury in the Circuit Court, Hinds County, James D. Bell, J., of attempted kidnapping, and he appealed. The Supreme Court, Robertson, J., held that: (1) evidence of planned but foiled attempt to rob grocery store was admissible as other crimes evidence to show motive, opportunity, or intent, and (2) conviction was supported by evidence of defendant's participation in attempt to forcibly seize and confine grocery store patron as he was entering his car.

Affirmed.
