Defendant was convicted in the Circuit Court, Hinds County, Reuben V. Anderson, Special Judge, of forgery, and he appealed. The Supreme Court, Lee, J., held that where defendant offered no evidence to rebut prima facie case of forgery and did not attempt to overcome presumption resulting from his possession of the forged instrument, evidence was sufficient to support the guilty verdict returned by the jury.

Affirmed.
