Upon affirmance of conviction for house burglary, [495 So.2d 510](#), petitioner filed pro se motion for postconviction relief on grounds that State's primary witness committed perjury when witness testified that petitioner was involved in burglary. The Supreme Court, [505 So.2d 1014.Hawkins](#), P.J., granted application for leave to file motion in trial court. The Circuit Court, Hinds County, [L. Breland Hilburn, Jr.](#), J., denied motion. Petitioner appealed. The Supreme Court, Roy Noble Lee, C.J., held that petitioner was entitled to new trial.

Reversed and remanded.
